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## V. PUBLIC REPRESENTATION IN NOIDA BOARD:

In the absence of publicly elected representatives, like municipal councilors etc., which provide a desired link between the public and the authority, functions relating to provision of civic amenities may not be looked after well, in the best interests of the citizens of Noida. **We have, therefore, been pleading that at least two representatives from our Federation, may be associated with Noida Board** in order to assist NA in regard to the formulation of the requisite policies/procedures which may be in the best interests of the citizens and for effective implementation thereof.. In this connection, may we also submit that in the past, an **Advisory Committee, comprising of two representatives of residents and one representative of industrialists, had been set up in the year 2001 and the same existed till 2005. We would, therefore, earnestly request you to kindly have such an advisory committee set up again, until any final decision regarding representation in Noida Board could be reached.**

## VI. CONVERSION OF NOIDA LAND INTO FREE HOLD:

May we refer to our **long pending representations relating to conversion of Noida lease hold land into FREE HOLD.** In this connection, we would like to reiterate that even though Noida city has been set up more than 40 years ago, the system of Lease Hold has been prevalent since its inception: Consequently, Noida citizens are continually feeling quite insecure. May we submit that the system of lease hold does not exist in any other prominent city in the State of Uttar Pradesh. In the case of Greater Noida, land has been allotted to agencies of Ansal & DLF Groups on Free Hold basis for developing townships. **The lease hold lands in equally developed neighboring city of Delhi, have been converted into FREE HOLD more than 30 years ago.** Furthermore, majority of allottees in Noida have already paid one-time lease rent.

**U.P. Government has also now decided to convert land in industrial development authority areas, into FREE HOLD You will thus kindly appreciate that there is an essential, critical and urgent need to convert Noida Lease Hold land into FREE HOLD.**

## V. CRITICAL NEED/ JUSTIFICATION FOR CONTROL OF STRAY DOGS.

(a) The residents of Noida have been experiencing a great inconvenience, hardships & sufferings on account of roaming of stray dogs on the roads & streets in the city. There have been several incidents in the past where stray dogs have injured several people in various sector of Noida city. There have also been several instances wherein the lives of the injured persons could not be saved as they had succumbed after having been attacked by stray dogs.

(b) The menace is increasing day by day and there is hardly any check thereon. It has been reported that because of the stray dogs menace, the movement of children & senior citizens is restricted outside their homes. Apart from causing harm to the residents, particularly, children and senior citizens, stray dogs have been following the motorists, resulting in frequent serious accidents.
