© We have been repeatedly representing that SPCA, entrusted with the job, have not been performing effectively, despite their financial grant being continuously hiked by NA. The other agency now being deployed, namely, HSA, has too still not started operating. **As the problem has become quite enormous, it may kindly be appreciated that there is an essential need for at least 4/5 agencies to effectively tackle highly serious menace being faced by Noida residents.. May we earnestly appeal to you for your kind urgent directions for effective steps in this regard on war footing basis.**

VI. CRITICAL NEED FOR CONSTRUCTION OF BOUNDARY WALLS:

May we reiterate that in the absence of boundary walls around Sectors of Noida city, security of the residents of Sectors of Noida city is being adversely affected. Most of the Sectors of Noida city are unbound. **RWAs of Sectors of Noida have got installed security gates on the periphery of their Sectors, but the same are not bearing the desired results even though CCTVs have also been provided by them.** This is so because yet there are several openings around the Sectors wherefrom the criminals and bad elements enter the Sectors and easily escape through such openings after indulging in criminal activities. In respect of certain sectors, villages are adjacently mingled on one or two sides of their periphery, which also provide similar openings and result in security hazard and thus require construction of segregating boundary walls.

VII. DISPOSAL & TREATMENT OF MUNICIPAL WASTE. .

We wish to bring to your kind attention that **one of the most essential step (disposal & treatment of solid/municipal waste) relating to maintenance of cleanliness in the city, has not yet been enforced.** Consequently, planned and adequate arrangements even for lifting of **KACHHRA** & other waste material from the houses, on daily basis, do not exist. As a result, the **kachhra** and waste material, including bio-medical waste are being littered here and there, **causing serious health hazard for Noida residents.**

VIII. INADEQUATE QUANTITY AND SUB-STANDARD QUALITY OF DRINKING WATER

(a).. **QUANTITY**:. Against the prescribed hours for supply of water being seven, in actual practice, supply remains for about three hours.

(b) **QUALITY**: of water being supplied, continuous to be **hard, insoluble, contains a lot of sediment. It is, therefore, desirable that effective steps for improvement of quality of drinking water, such as installation of water treatment plants etc., are taken on due priority basis.**

© In this connection, it may be recalled that while we had agitated against last hike in water consumption tariff, you had kindly assured that quality of drinking water shall be adequately improved.

IX.. EVICTION OF ENCROACHMENTS ON ROADS AND PLOTS IN SECTORS:

Since Noida has become a notified township, appropriate civic bye-laws need to be framed and put into effective implementation, In the absence of such bye-laws, it is noted that Encroachments are not evicted timely. NA staff comes into operation only after situation becomes out of control as with each passing day, the encroachment gets proliferated.
