## X. EXTENSIVE DRIVE FOR CLEANING OF NALAS AND STORM WATER DRAINS.

We wish to bring to your kind attention that NALAS and storm water drains in residential Sectors are not being cleaned on regular basis. Even before and during the monsoon season, regrettably, no cleaning drive is being carried out. You will kindly appreciate that it is most critical to have the NALAS and storm water drains cleaned on regular basis, keeping in view the frequent outbreak of dreaded diseases like dengue and malaria.. It is, therefore, essential and desirable to carry out an extensive drive for cleaning of NALAS and storm water drains on at least quarterly basis rather than existing practice of once a year before the onset of monsoon. To rid the residents of facing continued unhygienic condition, requisite plan may be devised to cover them., as a long-term solution.

## XI. ALLOTMENT OF LAND FOR SPORTS & CULTURAL CLUBS IN SECTORS

May we reiterate that it is quite difficult for the tiny tots/youngsters/ senior citizens of the different Sectors to reach Noida Stadium in Sector 21A on account of the obvious reasons viz. Security/distances etc.. To achieve the objectives of promoting sports, indoor games as also provision of requisite recreational facilities in the sectors throughout Noida city and raising of physical standards of the younger generation, it is absolutely essential that all the Sectors are provided appropriate space for indoor games, such as, Badminton, Table Tennis, Gyms & swimming pools etc. in the Sector(s) itself. Our RWA members have been pleading for taking up the matter for allotment of land for purpose of setting up Sports & Cultural Clubs in the sectors.

**XII. RGROUND POWER CABLES:** In absence of underground power cables having been laid, power supply is shut down even when there is minor hailstorm or wind blowing. Thus it is imperative that underground power cables are laid down in the Sectors on top priority basis.

## XIII PROVISION OF LARGE AUDITORIUM IN NOIDA CITY.

As you are kindly aware, there is no spacious auditorium in Noida city. As such, it becomes unmanageable to hold functions being attended by large number, such as, more than 500 persons. You will kindly appreciate that there is an urgent and essential need to set up a large auditorium, on the pattern of Habitat Centre, having a capacity of around 1,000.

## XIV. HARDSHIP TO COMMUTERS ON ACCOUNT OF ONE-WAY RESTRICTION.

While we appreciate initiate of requisite steps for smooth movement of traffic and avoidance of jams, we note that one-way restrictions on certain roads, have caused avoidable hardship to the residents, e.g. Udyog Vihar Road, facing Noida Authority. This has resulted in under utilization of the road.
